## Membership Point System

Thespian membership is granted for the performance of meritorious work in theatre arts which meets the International Thespian Society’s general guidelines; students become members by earning points for their work.

The points listed below are the **maximum** that usually may be earned for a specific assignment.

- One point represents approximately ten hours of excellent work.
- To attain Thespian membership, a student must earn ten points, five of which must be acquired at the school where he or she is to be inducted.
- A student must participate in at least two full-length productions, or one full-length and two one-acts. Participation should be in at least two of the listed categories, for example, Acting and Production.
